With its classic opening lines, "It was the night before Christmas, when all over the house/no creature moved, not even a mouse", this poem is always one of the most popular to read and read aloud during the Christmas season. Modernist poet E. E. Cummings (or e.e. Cummings, as he preferred to write it), wrote a sweet address to a Christmas tree called [post]. The narrator of the poem speaks to the Christmas tree, describing how it will be decorated, and then says to the tree: "When you're well dressed/you'll be at the window so everyone can see/and how they'll look at you!" Margaret Deland's Lanthe Waits, you meet children singing cheerfully A quirky poem by Ted Kooser called Christmas Mail takes you around town with the courier and imagines all the Christmas postcards he carries in his purse, including those with pastries "Wartime Christmas by Joyce Kilmer is an inspiring reflection on how, even in the worst moments, Christmas can bring hope to those who need it. "As long as there's love and home... and these..." Sometimes, the most memorable poems are the ones they catch details of everyday moments, such as Mary Jo Salter's Advent. This poem describes a mother and daughter building a gingerbread house together. "Somehow I smashed a wall, / the last one in the house / we're making gingerbread". In Walter de La Mare's Vischio, you can almost see a Christmas party wrapping up while the narrator, sitting under the mistletoe, says, "A last candle burning low, / All of the Sleepy dancers gone, / Just a burning candle, / shadows lurking everywhere".
