The person who rolls the highest total on all five dice goes first. Each player has three opportunities to roll the dice, with the goal of scoring the highest points from various combinations. After each roll, players can choose to stop and mark their points or continue rolling. Yahtzee With Buddies includes a rulebook, scoring sheets, five dice, plastic markers, and a rolling cup, providing everything needed for an engaging game night. After marking your score, play moves left and your turn is over. On the scorecard, there are 13 columns corresponding to the 13 rounds in each game. For example, if you roll three 3s, one 2, and one 4, you can score a 9 in the threes box, a 2 in the twos box, or a 4 in the fours box. The goal of the Upper Section is to earn 63 points by any combination to get a 35-point bonus. This section scores only if you roll three or more of the same number on the dice. Alternatively, you can score the total number in this section or the total of all dice in the Chance section. Similarly, if you roll four or more of the same number on the dice, you can score it here. Totaling 25 points earns a Full House, regardless of which numbers make up the house. This is always 25 points. You can also score three dice as 3 of a Kind and all five dice in the Chance box as long as they are sequential. This will earn you 30 points if your four dice form a small straight with no gaps. Alternatively, you can replace this score in the Chance section instead of the small straight box. Rolling a sequence of five consecutive numbers earns you 40 points and is considered a large straight, regardless of where it starts. Small Straight is worth 30 points. Joker Rules allow you to score in any Lower Section box even if you've already marked zero. For instance, if you roll five 5s and have a zero in the Large Straight Box, you can still mark 40 in that box. The probability of winning changes depending on your strategy; players who focus on Yahtzees will have different odds than those aiming for high scores. A single Yahtzee has a 4.61% chance of occurring or 1 in 22 turns. The chances drastically decrease to 0.077% per roll. The highest possible score is 1575, achievable only by rolling a Yahtzee every round, with odds of about 0.00000000000000043797%. An optimized strategy scores an average of 255 points, while strictly trying for Yahtzees yields 172 points on average. The game ends when all players fill the 13 columns; then, each player calculates their score by adding up the Upper and Lower Sections, with a bonus for scoring 63 or more in the Upper Section.
