



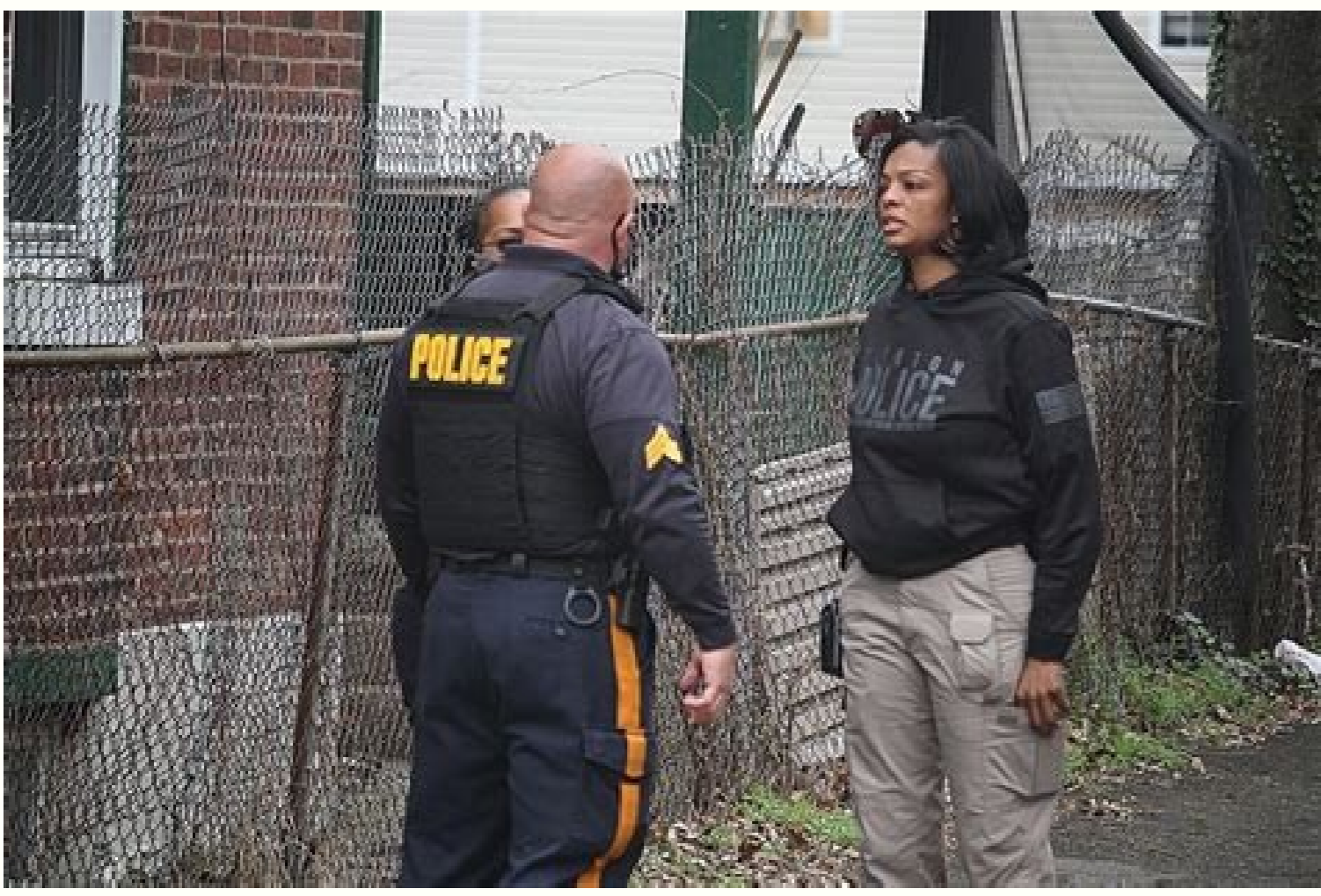

The State Police of New Jersey often receives investigations of government, businesses and citizens about regulations and procedures to obtain a person's criminal record. This website has been developed to help you answer the most common questions about this process. New Jersey Administrative Code (N.J.A.C.) 13: 59-1 and SSQ, authorizes the diffusion of information on the registration of the New Jersey Criminal History (Chr) by the State Police of New Jersey (NJSP), Identification and Information Technology section (I benefit), State Identification Office (SING) with Non-criminal justice purposes. This will begin for applicants who program appointments with identical on July 1, 2021. To download the personal registration request letter, applicants and / or employers will need to authenticate the PCN of IdeToGo, Surname and Date of Birth As introduced in the IdeToGo form. Applicants and / or employers will have up to 90 days from the date of fingerprinting date to download the personal registration request letter. If after 90 days, the applicant will have to go through the process of requesting personal file again and receiving fingerprints. The State Police Division, Criminal Information Unit (CIU) provides New Jersey's criminal background checks based on fingerprints to any resident of the state of New Jersey requesting a copy of his own criminal record. A request for personal registration is typically with the purpose of: good immigration behavior Naturalization Personal Record Visa Adoption International Expungement of company All personal registration requests are only Bisquards of the State of New Jersey. A person can obtain a check of the criminal record by it by electronic scanning live on one of the approved sites for fingerprinting. The New Jersey State Police uses fingerprint scanning services provided by Idemia, a private enterprise contracted with the state of New Jersey. To be fingerprints for any of the purposes listed above, you must contact IDEMIA to schedule an hour and a place to take your fingerprints on an IdentoGO site. The quickest and easiest way to schedule your appointment is through the World Wide Web at . Web programming is 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Applicants who do not have access to World Wide Web must call IDEMIA on the company's free phone, 1-877-503-5981 (Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon). Hispanic-speaking operators are available on request. You should bring the appropriate identification with the address that the appointment was scheduled with as described on the IDEMIA website. Appointment registration and location information will be available in the Idemia Universal Registration Platform (UEP), which will allow applicants to schedule appointments using a single service code for each agency/identification reason. IDEMIA has assigned a Service Code for every single combination of agency and type of applicant. The six-character service code is used to uniquely identify the Agency (ORI), and the reason for identifying fingerprints (RFP). The use of the Service Code ensures that applicants are printed for the right purpose and are not being accidentally or incorrectly processed for a service they do not need. The distribution of the Service Code depends on the agency to confirm that the correct applicants have the right service. Below is a list of criminal records Background controls provided by the New Jersey State Police. The corresponding service codes are listed for each type of application. The rate for this fingerprint service is \$44.13, which includes the supplier rate of \$14.13 and the associated state sales tax. The following forms of payment are accepted: VISA, Master Card, American Express, Discover, prepaid debit cards or electronic debit (ACH) from a checking account. The payment will be collected on the Idemia fingerprint site on the scheduled date. Appointments must be before 5:00 p.m. on business day before your scheduled time (must be cancelled for Saturday at noon for a Monday appointment). Lack of complete and accurate information may result in having to be typed again and Additional costs. (There are no refunds once a Criminal History Background Check is completed). The questions or revisions of the answers must be done within a period of ninety days (90) or the entire process will have to be repeated. The VRO will process the applicants' fingerprints, review the records and respond to the

registered organization with a letter that will notify a recommendation for approval or denial. # The registered organization will not receive a copy of the applicant's registration under this program. The VRO will review and make a determination based on the disqualifiers listed in the law. Back to Top Noncriminal Justice Volunteer Background Checks / Volunteer Care Provider (VCP) Program (records from NJ only): N.J.A.C. 13:59-1 et seq. provides background checks for non-criminal justice volunteers to: Any person who volunteers with a qualified entity, as defined in the National Child Protection Act of 1993, 42 U.S.C. § 5119, 5119c; Any person who volunteers their services to an entity that has been designated by the Internal Revenue System as exempt from federal income tax pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 501 (c) (3); or any volunteer with a non-profit organization who provides services to youth. There are two (2) options available to an applicant under the PCV. Fingerprint-based VCP Check (NJ records only): An applicant may choose to perform a more complete check, based on a fingerprint comparison using the service code provided below. The fee for the electronic footprint is 32.13. These responses will be sent directly to the employer's address provided by the applicant. The following forms of payment are accepted: VISA, Master Card, American Express, Discover prepaid debit or electronic debit (ACH) from a checking account. Accounts will be debited immediately. Return to Home Name-based checks (only New Jersey records): Form SBI 212B was developed to provide the following entities with the ability to request criminal background checks based on the name of a subject, date of birth, number of social insurance and other descriptive information: Government entities of this state, the federal government or any other state for any official government purpose, including: A person or non-governmental entity of any authorized State. If an authorized applicant chooses to perform a more thorough check, based on the comparison of the fingerprints, he or she may select one of the proofs based on the fingerprints described above. The answers will return directly to the employer's address listed in the event of the fingerprint appointment. The state supplier NICUSA has developed a web platform to send the SBI 212B form. The rate for an online presentation of SBI 212B is \$20, a credit card or debit. E-mail addresses should be provided both for the applicant (employer) and for the subject (employee) of the criminal history based on the name Name The applicant (employer) may make the payment (employee), but the subject must consent to the verification of criminal record through the online verification process (with the exception of the licensed private detectives performing their legal authorized functions). The applicant (employer) must initiate the online 212b process for the specific subject (employed). The subject (employed) cannot initiate the process for the applicant (employer). All licensed private detectives will have to set up an account on the website before sending SBI 212B requests. It is also strongly suggested, but it is not necessary, that each employer creates an account in the NICUSA 212B portal. Setting up an account through NICUSA will allow users to access background checks based on the name electronically. Without an account, you will only receive an email of the results and will not be able to get a copy. In the near future, the creation of an account will be necessary to use the name checks service. SBI 212B forms may not be used for a person requesting their own record of criminal history. Someone who wishes to receive their own registration must send fingerprints using one of the methods described above, according to n.j.a.c. 13: 59-1 et seq.
