2024 ram uconnect hard reset

Hello to all Ram Brand enthusiasts-- We wanted to make some instructions for resetting/rebooting your Uconnect 5 systems easily accessible. There are two methods: Soft Reset/Reboot or Factory Reset. Soft Reset/Reboot: Open the VEHICLE app --> scroll to SETTINGS --> scroll to RESET and choose one of the following options - SOFT RESET/REBOOT - performs a cold reboot which completely restarts the radio and all peripheral devices in the radio, or FACTORY RESET. The latter *CAUTION: This action wipes saved user data from the radio and reverts everything back to factory default settings. We recommend deleting and re-pairing any mobile devices after performing a factory reset. Hard Button Reset Option: Press and hold the "power button/knob" in for 10 seconds or more. Deleting & Re-Pairing Mobile Devices - For Apple device, go to Settings>General>Carplay>Forget this Device; on radio, go to Phone>Settings> Select Device in List and Delete the device; then restart phone and pair again. Please ensure that your mobile phone's software and Uconnect software are both up to date, and make sure Siri is on & CarPlay is not restricted. Go to Settings > Screen Time > Content & Privacy Restrictions, tap Allowed Apps and ensure CarPlay is enabled. If you experience concerns after a reboot of your Uconnect 5 system does not mitigate these concerns, please don't hesitate to send our team a private message with your VIN and any additional details/documentation that will help us get a better understanding of your situation. My brand new Ram's UConnect 5 system suddenly went blank on me, which was really frustrating. The salesperson had promised it would be fast, but my experience so far has been pretty choppy. I couldn't even figure out how to split the screen like I did with my old model. Maybe it just needs an update? My car is a 2021, and I'm hoping that's all it takes to fix these issues. On another note, I have a question about the Siri function on my 2022 Ram - can you completely disable it? I had a similar experience with one of my other devices at home where it started joining conversations from another room, which was super creepy. I ended up unplugging it. I'm experiencing some weird bugs with my UConnect 5 system too. The navigation through CarPlay keeps stopping, the screen flickers, and when on a call, it randomly switches between car speakers and phone audio. It's really annoying! And to make matters worse, the app is super expensive - at least \$30/month in Canada for the fully loaded plan. I'm not willing to pay that much just to use some of the features. Thanks to this community, though, I was able to troubleshoot my own issue with the 12-inch screen going dark after a cold snap here in Denver. It turned out that the system updated itself overnight, and everything came back online! I'm so grateful to this community for their help - thank you all so much!!! Infotainment systems can be a huge advantage for drivers today, but issues with this tech are sadly common. Luckily, there are some simple things you can try at home to get your Uconnect system up and running again. Found in all Chrysler-made vehicles, including Dodge, Jeep, and Ram models, Uconnect infotainment systems need the right approach to fix. Check out the steps below to learn how to figure out which version of the system you have, and find the correct directions to reset it. If a reboot fails, consider reaching out to vehicle electronics experts for further guidance. Identifying Your Uconnect Version With multiple versions of Uconnect out there, it's essential to identify yours before trying any fixes. Once you know your version, you can look up specific restart instructions, avoiding potential confusion. A little research will make it much easier to get your infotainment system working again. Search for Your Version - Jeep, Dodge, Ram, Chrysler Models To find out which Uconnect version is in your vehicle, simply look up your model, year, and trim level. Soft Reset Steps Before attempting a Uconnect hard reset, we recommend trying a soft reset. This preserves all your saved data in the infotainment system and can fix many common issues. To do a soft reset, head to "Apps," click on "Vehicle," then go to "Settings" and down to "Reset." You should find an option saying something like "Soft Reset." Click that, and your system will restart itself. Give it some time, and hopefully, everything will start working normally again. If this doesn't work for you, a hard reset will be the next step. Get back on track with the Vehicle app by entering the Settings menu again and clicking on Reset, but this time opt for the "Factory Reset" choice. Be aware that your saved settings will be erased, requiring you to re-pair your phone with the vehicle afterwards. Confirm the reset process, then give the system sufficient time to complete its task - it may take a bit longer than a standard reboot due to wiping all settings and returning to factory defaults. Once finished, attempt various functions such as playing music or setting up your phone; if issues persist, consider consulting experts or replacing the infotainment system with an aftermarket upgrade. Prioritize trying both reset procedures before seeking further assistance. If stuck with a black screen and unable to navigate the menu, look for a way to initiate a soft reset via button combinations - this could help reactivate your screen. If all else fails, you may need to seek out a replacement infotainment system; explore options at local electronics stores or online, and consult professionals such as mechanics or sales representatives for guidance.
