Differences and reading approach: The idea of a chocolate moose for dinner should be shared with students before reading, and they should be encouraged to ask questions throughout. When reading the book aloud, the teacher should occasionally ask volunteers to read a page and do their best to explain it. If students are at a higher reading level, they can read the book independently and offer their best interpretation of the descriptions of each homônimo in the book, or work with the idea of languages. Before reading the story, ask students to guess what one homônimo? A homophone? If so, how you would describe one homophone? What is an example of a pair of homônimos? What is a language? Regardless of the students know what one homophone or language, the teacher may want to explain it before reading and have students work with the definition as the story is read. While reading the story, students try to decipher how the language or homophone should be interpreted as versus as illustrated in the book.
