If an employer communicates a salary increase to an employee, they should mention the amount and formalities required. **Writing a Salary Increase Email** When writing an email requesting a salary increase, it's necessary to title it properly and place the request in a polite manner. Strong reasons should be mentioned, and if applicable, necessary documents can be attached. Example: Subject: Request for Salary Review Dear [Boss's Name], I am writing to request a salary review based on my performance over the past year. I have consistently met—and often exceeded—my performance targets, contributing to key projects like [Project Name/Details]. Best regards, [Employee's Name] Looking forward to seeing everyone at the meeting tomorrow and discussing our strategies. Looking forward to meeting everyone at the team gathering tomorrow to discuss our project progress and strategies in more detail. I have been actively taking on additional responsibilities within my role, such as [specific achievements], and have received positive feedback from colleagues and supervisors alike. I believe that a salary increase would be fitting considering these contributions and would motivate me to continue delivering high-quality work for the team. Please let us schedule a meeting at your earliest convenience to discuss this further.
