EMS Academy Texas Fire Academy offers the Emergency Medical Technician - Basic course in two different formats: night class with lecture, in person skills, and online coursework, and a shorter hybrid class that is only online coursework and in person skills. Students will have the opportunity to experience clinical field training in an Emergency Room and on a working Ambulance. Clinical rotations will be conducted outside of class time in 8-12 hour shifts. All clinical rotations are completed before the final exam. After completion of the course, students will be eligible to take the National Registry Exam. This course meets the TDSHS curriculum requirements. Advanced Courses The advanced Fire courses offered by Texas Fire Academy are: Driver Operator Pumper, Fire Instructor I and II, and Fire Officer I and II, Fire Inspector I, II and Plans Examiner, Fire Investigator, Introduction to Advanced Fire/Arson Scene Investigations, Advanced Arson Investigations, Basic Fire Scene Photography, Incident Safety Officer (ISO), Fire & Life Safety Educator I and II coming soon. These classes are completed in a convenient online environment. The student will only need to come to the academy for the final exam and skills evaluation on the last day in most cases. After completion of any of these classes, the student will be eligible to take the TCFP exam for certification. It is your option to attend either the traditional twelve-week firefighter training classroom format where the student attends class Monday through Friday for a twelve week period. During this time the student receives instruction in the various subjects associated with firefighting. In addition the required hands-on skills are practiced until mastered by each individual. The tuition for this course is \$3,000.00. Housing is not included in this tuition, however, if the student requires housing, you can contract with a local volunteer fire department where the student may house and ride out with the volunteer department as an observer, while they attend the fire academy. If your work schedule, family life, or other issues prevent you from attending a twelve-week on site course, perhaps the online fire academy format of training will better fit your needs. In this type of training the student enrolls in the course and has twelve weeks to work through the self-paced online presentations, practice tests, assessment tests, and associated course work from their home. At the conclusion of the twelve week self-paced online portion of training the student attends a fourteen (14) day hands-on skills' session in which the online material is reviewed and all of the skills related to being a firefighters are practiced until mastered. On the final day of the session, the Texas Commission on Fire Protection State Examination will be administered. The tuition for this course is \$2,700.00. Housing is included in the tuition. KILGORE, Texas (KLTV) - Kilgore High School is one of 12 high schools in East Texas that is taking part in the high school fire academy program. The program, run by Kilgore College, will give high school seniors interested in working in fire services a chance to get their basic fire certification. Michael Simmons, director of the Kilgore College Fire Academy, said after graduation, those students will be able to come to Kilgore College for a 10-day boot camp to complete physical skills, afterwards they will take their state test and be able to be certified as a State of Texas firefighter. "There are a lot of retirements taking place through the Baby Boomer generation getting older, but also in East Texas we have a hard time retaining firefighters because a lot of the firefighters come out of the Metroplex or Austin area or Houston area, take a first time job here and as soon as they have the opportunity to go back to their home they do so," Simmons said. "So fire departments have a hard time retaining employees, so the idea of this program is to partner with the local fire departments, partner with the local high schools and grow a work force here in East Texas of folks who are from East Texas." Simmons said the course is a mixture of academic book learning as well as getting a chance to actually work with the gear. "The hands on learning experience is extremely important, we are trying to use the flip classroom concept where we shorten the lecture time, try to put some hands on," he said. "I heard about the program through the school and I just thought it was an amazing thing to do. It seems like an amazing thing to be a firefighter and to experience what a firefighter would do and just learn more about it," said senior Wyatt Woodley. Senior Yonathan Cervantes says he believes the course will give him a good opportunity to gain the experience he needs to jump into the field. "I feel it's going to be a pretty good experience because we are going learn more about it, hopefully to become one and actually have a career in it," he said. Copyright 2021 KLTV. TEEEX Fire Training Academy prepares you for success as an entry-level firefighter. This is a 12-week program consisting of classroom and hands-on field application training. Our cadets must excel academically, demonstrate exceptional teamwork and leadership skills, and establish professional behavior. This program meets or exceeds all requirements set by the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX), Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP), and the following National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards: NFPA 1001, Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications (2019 edition) NFPA 470, Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) Standard for Responders (2022 edition) In addition, you will receive the following certificates as part of completing this course: This course provides a total of 545 hours of training and is held at TEEEX Brayton Fire Training Field, College Station, TX. Applicants for either TEEEX Recruit Fire Academy must meet the following requirements: Be a high school graduate or have passed a GED test Be at least 18 years of age International applicants must meet the following additional requirements: Pass an English proficiency exam (coordinated through the TEEEX International Student Advisor) To complete your application process to the Fire Training Academy, you must do the following Pay the \$75.00 non-refundable and non-transferable application fee through the TEEEX Website Submit a completed Recruit Fire Academy Participant Enrollment Agreement. Submit a color copy of a driver's license or a form of government- or state-issued identification. Submit a copy of a high school diploma or GED completion: Applicants that are still in high school at the time of enrollment are required to provide a letter from the school stating eligibility for graduation and date. College transcripts are also accepted as proof of high school completion. Register with TCFP ( ) and provide FIDO pin number to registrar. Submit proof of meningitis vaccination: Participants under the age of twenty-two must meet the requirements of vaccination within the last five years and a minimum of ten days prior to the first day of the traditional academy or boot camp. Please refer to the TEEEX website for more information about meningitis requirements and exemptions. A representative from TEEEX will review your application and contact you if you've been cleared to complete the registration process and pay the balance of your tuition. Important: Upon approval of your application to enroll in the TEEEX Recruit Fire Academy, you will be required to submit a medical evaluation prior to the first day of class.
