## Skyrim reset marriage quest

I think most of the other answers (or comments) here say pretty much the same thing I've read and heard here and in other places: In Skyrim, marriage is forever. Marriage Ceremony: After your spouse pledges his or her vows, they will sometimes depart the temple while Maramal is still speaking and vanish, never to be seen again. That is just a floating rumor. He will start you from scratch. From UESP wiki, "Skyrim - Marriage" article: Steps to re-marry / divorce using console commands (PC only): Select spouse. – If you're having difficulties getting the amulet to function (as I was; I'd completed the whole Amulet quest and was still unable to have any marriage chat), return to Maramal in Riften. Use the console to enter these commands: completequest 0007431B; resetquest ... Use the console to enter these commands: completequest 0007431B resetquest 0007431B resetquest 00021382 (This is just futility to reset the "marriage" quest.) The above will prevent the player from having to kill his spouse, although they will comment on how much even the thought of him makes their blood boil. tried this out but Maramal won't give me the same dialogueThats really odd! I tested this on my save in which my wife, also Lydia, had died. As you point out, you don't seem to be alone. Just talk to any local innkeeper about "marriage" for 30 seconds and then go back home The "skyrim reset marriage quest console command" is a command that can be used to reset the marriage quest in Skyrim. Go to riften and talk to the temple of mara guy. 24 hours must be waited. Players who have completed all the goals will not get married and those that have met one or more of the requirements but haven't finished them yet will remain single.

Read my previous thread for the reason why (posted this before finding the resetquest function): 2: No courier, as far as I know, will ever come up to you after your wife dies and give you a note saying you can remarry. Buy a new amulet, go get married again.Note: Simply adding an NPC to the faction 19809 using addfac or addtofaction will not work to solve this problem, despite many people saying otherwise. Talk to temple of mara guy in Riften, meet nice girl (or guy), take her there, tried this out but Maramal won't give me the same dialogueEnigma Kid posted...sadly, it didn't work for me unless I did something wrong. You aren't the first person to have this not work though, so I wonder what's up. The addfac 19809 only allows a npc that normally cant get married, get the ability. Untested, but possibly setrelationshipprank player 4 can fix this Option two The spouse must be killed The console command Setstage RelationshipMarriage 10 must then be used The console commands resurrect should next be used on the ex-spouse (and eventually the command setrelationshipprank player 4 on him/her to keep the relationship status obtained with the NPC related quests) The old Amulet of Mara doesn't need to be dropped or sold. Is it possible to marry again if you refuse to marry Skyrim? Type "resetquest RelationshipMarriage"-> Drop your amulet from your inventory. When does the Minecraft wedding ceremony take place? In Skyrim, you'll need to finish at least two out of three marriage-related quests in order to reset your quest line and marry whomever you want; if you do so, however, it's very easy. You can never remarry after being widowed or leave your husband for another. Then, go back to your betrothed and tell them you're no longer interested. Option three The Amulet of Mara necklace must be retained, or another one must be found. The following commands must be used, after targeting the spouse: removefac 51596 player.removefac C6472 resetquest 74793 resetquest 21382 setstage 74793 10 The old spouse will immediately exit the house and return to their regular location. Simply keep track of the time and create a backup BEFORE proposing, ideally in front of your future spouse, followed instructions exactly. Marriage quests are a feature of Elder Scrolls, where the player is given multiple objectives to complete before they can be with their spouse. However, the previous statement still stands - once you've said your "I do's, it's a done deal forever. When you get married, you complete the quest. From TES Wiki, "Marriage - Divorce (PC)" article: Trying to breakup with partners is, for some reason, impossible without the console. So yeah, your problem does have a solution. For eg- if your follower ever died, and you revived them, you will need to ask then to follow you again. Having said that, I feel the question is a little misleading. The priest will inform you that the ceremony will take place the next day between dawn and nightfall, or between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. Since you can access 'console by ~ key, just type the following commands to make her your wife again: Click on Lydia addfac 19809 1 And you are done! She is your wife again. That means there is no divorce, and death does not end a marriage either. (Or, until you reload to a previous save.) If you're playing on PC, you can use the Console to reset the quest and remarry. The wedding ceremony must be handled with caution. Well, I actually had to reload it and try again cause I had the amulet in my inventory which messed hi. This can effectively be done by simply not showing up at the temple, at the appointed time. To see his inventory, type 'pickpocket'. I then went to whiterun and ysolda, after I put the amulet on, was super interested again. This may be avoided if you leave the ceremony promptly and begin a discussion with your husband about where you should reside. Answers The wedding ceremony must be handled with caution. On a side note, if you are stuck in a location (and fast travel is not an option for whatever reason), you can use a combination of this command and a teleport command to effectively restart the quest. The cool part is that you can use it in any NPC.
