Performing a factory reset on a barcode scanner may vary depending on the device's make and model, but generally involves scanning specific barcodes from the user manual or using manufacturer-provided software tools. This guide outlines the process for popular barcode scanners, including general steps and model-specific instructions. For Zebra USB Wired Scanners, you'll need to: 1. Power off the device by disconnecting it from its USB port and waiting 30 seconds. 2. Reconnect the device to the desired USB port. 3. Scan the "Restore Defaults" barcode provided below to reset the device. After resetting, you may also need to add the Carriage Return/Line Feed function if the barcode is not automatically adding products to the cart. If this doesn't resolve connectivity issues with an Android Tablet, install the Zebra Technologies Scanner Control app from the Google Play Store and restore defaults again. This should make your USB device detectable with the app. Once restored, navigate to the Find Cabled Scanner page in the Scanner Control app and scan the provided barcode. Close the app and return to your Cultivera POS App to test the scanner. If issues persist, consider contacting Zebra's customer support or referring to their official documentation for troubleshooting guidance.
