In the process, the Hardik Pandya-led side become the fourth and final team to qualify for the playoffs. Earlier in the evening, Suryakumar Yadav smashed an unbeaten 73 off 43 deliveries, collecting seven fours and four sixes along the way as Mumbai Indians recovered from a slowdown in the middle overs to post a competitive 180/5 on the board after stand-in Delhi Capitals skipper Faf du Plessis opted to field at the Wankhede Stadium. Thank you and good night!May 21, 2025, 23:53:32 (IST)While Santner and Bumrah were outstanding in the middle overs, SKY proved to be the difference between the two sides with his blistering knock on a tough Wankhede pitch helping MI post 180 on a wicket where 160 would have been a good total.May 21, 2025, 23:29:19 (IST)MI owner Nita Ambani too joins the rest of the team and support staff in thanking the Wankhede crowd for their support in the 18th season, which has witnessed the five-time champions bounce back in style after a familiar slow start in which they lost four out of their first five matches.May 21, 2025, 23:27:59 (IST)Bumrah finishes with superb figures of 3/12, getting rid of Mustafizur Rahman for a golden duck, as Mumbai Indians become the fourth and final team to enter the playoffs with a 59-run thrashing of the Delhi Capitals.It was against the Delhi Capitals that Mumbai Indians began their turnaround earlier this season, collecting a thrilling 12-run win at the Arun Jaitley Stadium after losing four of their first five matches of the season. That would be the beginning of a six-match winning streak that would have the Hardik Pandya-led side topping the points table at one point.Wednesday's meeting between the two sides at the Wankhede Stadium, however, couldn't be more different with Mumbai Indians absolutely bossing the game apart from a slowdown in the middle overs during their innings.May 21, 2025, 23:16:02 (IST)Kuldeep sends the ball high in the air but hardly gets the distance needed for the ball to clear the fence, resulting in a simple catch for substitute Raj Bawa near long on. DC 120/9 after 18; need 61 off 12May 21, 2025, 23:10:30 (IST)A five per cent chance in rain certainly looks promising for everyone involved, for players as well as for those turning up at the Wankhede Stadium or watching the game from the comfort of their homes.May 21, 2025, 23:09:33 (IST)Delhi Capitals' playoff hopes a virtually extinguished in Mitchell Santner's final over of the evening as the Kiwi left-arm spinner, making his first appearance in nearly a month, gets rid of Sameer Rizvi and Ashutosh Sharma in a space of four deliveries. DC needed at least one of the two to stay till the end for them to have a chance, but are facing a bit of a big loss with both gone.Jasprit Nigam castles Madhav Tiwari with a slower delivery in the following over to leave Mumbai Indians needing two more wickets for a huge win! DC 110/8 after 16; need 71 to win off 24May 21, 2025, 22:56:24 (IST)Pandya decides to bring Chahar and Boult back into the attack. Chahar concedes 11 in his third over, with Rizvi collecting two fours in the last three deliveries of the over. Rizvi also hits Boult for a boundary in the following over to bring up the hundred for Delhi Capitals, who reach the milestone in the 14th over, the same as Mumbai Indians. The only difference between the two is the fact that Delhi have lost two wickets more than their opponents at the same stage. DC 103/5 after 14; need 78 off 36May 21, 2025, 22:47:24 (IST)Jacks completely misjudges the trajectory of the ball and ends up gifting Rizvi a boundary by making a mess what should have been a regulation catch. To make matters worse, Ashutosh Sharma – who had collected a four earlier in the over – targets the same region two balls later and comfortably clears the fence to collect a six in the final delivery.Santner, however, keeps things tidy by conceding just two singles in the following delivery, ensuring Delhi remain under scoreboard pressure. DC 84/5 after 12; need 97 off 48May 21, 2025, 22:38:48 (IST)Tristan Stubbs is the latest Delhi Capitals batter to receive the marching orders as Bumrah traps him leg-before with a delivery that jags back in sharply and hits him plumb in front of middle. The South African burns a review on his way to the dugout. And an outstanding second over from Bumrah as he concedes just a single along with the wicket, having conceded six from the two overs that he has bowled so far. DC 66/5 after 10; need 115 to win from 60May 21, 2025, 22:29:22 (IST)And he ends up getting dismissed by the very same bowler who had nearly dismissed him in the final over of the powerplay. Vipraj looks to punch a length ball from Santner that comes to him a lot more quickly than expected, but gets in a bit of a tangle and can only chip the ball back to the bowler. Just six runs in the two overs after powerplay as DC reach 55/4 after 8May 21, 2025, 22:23:33 (IST)Nigam had steered DC to a thrilling victory over LSG from a similar position in their opening game of the season, and his presence at the crease will be crucial for the team to keep their playoff hopes alive.MI, meanwhile, introduce spin from both ends with Mitchell Santner conceding six in the final over of the powerplay - including a four off his first delivery of the evening. And Rohit ends up handing Vipraj a lifeline by dropping a simple catch at short third man in the final delivery of the powerplay.May 21, 2025, 22:12:45 (IST)Outstanding glovework by Ryan Rickelton behind the stumps as Porel's back foot is found to be marginally airborne after a loss of balance. And an equally good bowling by Jacks as he beats Porel completely after drawing him into a forward defence. The over, however, goes haywire for the Englishman after he oversteps in the next delivery, getting hit for a six in the Free Hit followed by back-to-back fours, resulting in a 16-run over. DC 43/3 after 5May 21, 2025, 22:04:43 (IST)Rizvi and Porel find themselves needing to build a solid partnership in order to rescue the Capitals from a poor start. And the former announces himself with a pull towards the fine leg fence in the penultimate delivery of the fourth over. DC 27/2 after 4May 21, 2025, 22:01:53 (IST)Massive blow for the Delhi Capitals as they would have hoped for the in-form KL Rahul, who has scored an unbeaten 112 against Gujarat Titans in the previous game, depart, for 11 from 6 balls after nicking the ball to wicketkeeper Ryan Rickelton, who completes a fine catch. Rahul had charged down the track looking to smash the ball towards the midwicket region, only to get a bottom edge. DC 20/2 after 3May 21, 2025, 21:54:33 (IST)Du Plessis looks to smash Chahar for a six down the ground, but regrets the shot right away soon as he spots Santner standing at the edge of the boundary. Comfortable catch for the Kiwi spinner as the Capitals lose their first wicket with just 11 on the board. DC 14/1 after 2May 21, 2025, 21:48:37 (IST)KL Rahul opens the Capitals' account with a boundary off the very first delivery of the chase, although it's a streaky one as a thick outside edge carries just wide of short third man. Two balls later, Faf du Plessis goes for a punch through the cover region. Stand-in skipper du Plessis retains the strike with a single off the last ball. DC 10/0 after 1May 21, 2025, 21:40:40 (IST)Trent Boult will begin the proceedings for the Mumbai Indians. He had struck early against the same team at the Arun Jaitley Stadium earlier this season. Can he deliver another early breakthrough tonight?May 21, 2025, 21:36:30 (IST)Surya starts off with a four at the start of the over and turns down a single in the following delivery. Turns out to be the right call from the well-set senior batter as he smacks the Sri Lankan pacer for back-to-back sixes followed by a clever four in the next three deliveries. He ends the innings with a single as MI plunder 48 runs in the last two overs! The unbroken partnership between Surya and Naman is worth 57 off 21 balls.Had it not been for ty ty spells from spinners Kuldeep Yadav and Vipraj Nigam as well as last-minute replacement Mustafizur Rahman, MI would have finished well above 200.May 21, 2025, 21:20:41 (IST)New batter Naman Dhir collects 20 of those 27 runs by smashing a four on either side of back-to-back sixes in the last four deliveries of Mukesh's spell. Stand-in skipper Faf du Plessis doesn't look pleased at all MI 159/5 after 19May 21, 2025, 21:13:52 (IST)And its another off-cutter that gets Delhi Capitals a wicket, as skipper Pandya gets a thick leading edge while attempting to smash the ball down the ground off Dushmantha Chameera's bowling, resulting in a simple catch for Mukesh Kumar at backward point. Naman Dhir joins SKY, who smashes Mustafizur for a four in the following over, at the centre after Pandya's dismissal. MI 132/5 after 18May 21, 2025, 20:57:07 (IST)Pacer Mukesh Kumar collects his second wicket of the evening after Tilak Varma holes out to Sameer Rizvi at long on while attempting to smash an off-cutter out of the park. Excellent recovery by Mukesh after getting hit for a boundary at the start of the over.Kuldeep Yadav bowls out his final over next up, conceding just four singles in it to sign off with excellent figures of 1/22. MI 118/4 after 16May 21, 2025, 20:44:16 (IST)Suryakumar Yadav brings up the milestone with a single at the start of the 14th over, bowled by Mustafizur Rahman. SKY later collects his first maximum of the innings by charging down the track and smashing the ball over long off. He collects a single in the final delivery to complete the fifty partnership with Tilak. MI 108/3 after 14May 21, 2025, 20:40:40 (IST)Chameera, returning for the first time since his 15-run over in the powerplay, keeps things tidy with three singles in the first four deliveries. Tilak decides to try something different and scoops the ball over the keeper's head in the penultimate delivery to try and boost Mumbai's scoring rate.Vipraj Nigam concedes just four in the following over to sign off with figures of 0/25.May 21, 2025, 20:35:34 (IST)Kuldeep Yadav and Vipraj Nigam are doing an excellent job in building pressure on the Mumbai Indians. MI reach 54/2 at the end of the powerplayMay 21, 2025, 20:00:46 (IST)A slightly expensive over from Mustafizur as he concedes 12 in his second over. Jacks gets a thick leading edge in the fourth delivery that doesn't safely nearly third man before running away for a four. Jacks then picks a slower ball in the following delivery, smashing it towards deep square leg. MI 46/1 after 5May 21, 2025, 19:58:05 (IST)Vipraj's introduction, however, doesn't exactly slam the brakes on the run flow from that end as the leg-spinner concedes nine in his first over, including a couple of boundaries to new batter Will Jacks – who like Rickelton and Bosch will not be available for the playoffs. Excellent over from the Bangladeshi pacer, conceding just three runs for the wicket. MI 25/1 after 3May 21, 2025, 19:47:01 (IST)Rickelton, who will be missing the playoffs later this year, smashes the Sri Lankan pacer for back-to-back sixes, both hit down the ground. The wicketkeeper-batter later collects a brace and a single. MI 22/0 after 2May 21, 2025, 19:41:33 (IST)Mukesh Kumar starts off with three singles in his first four balls before Rohit Sharma, playing at the Wankhede Stadium for the first time since he announced his Test retirement and had a stand named after him at his home ground, goes for an inside out shot over extra cover. Their previous match, against Gujarat Titans at the Wankhede Stadium, turned out to be quite the see-saw battle in which the Shubman Gill-led side were cruising at one stage in their chase of a 156-run target, only for MI to stage a superb fightback thanks to some outstanding bowling by Jasprit Bumrah, Trent Boult and Ashwani Kumar.The match, however, witnessed multiple interruptions due to rain, with the possibility of a washout appearing quite likely at one point. In the end, Rahul Tewatia and Gerald Coetzee got their team over the line after the target was revised to 147 from 19 overs, having to wait until the final delivery to secure their triumph.May 21, 2025, 17:42:49 (IST)A washout will not have a direct impact on MI and DC's qualification chances, i.e. neither team will get knocked out. As per AccuWeather, there's an 80 per cent chance of rain in Mumbai today (Wednesday), which could impact the IPL 2025 match between MI and DC.The MI vs DC match is highly important from the IPL 2025 playoffs perspective . MI are on 14 points while DC are on 13 points with two matches left for both teams. However, if MI win today, they will be guaranteed a place in the playoffs and DC will be eliminated. Only one playoff spot is up for grabs in the IPL 2025 and only two teams – MI and DC are still alive in the race.Naturally, Delhi Capitals would aim to avoid a defeat, but they would also not want a washout because then the points will be split and Mumbai will continue to hold the one-point advantage over Delhi. DC would ideally want to beat MI and take the playoffs race to the last round of the IPL league stage.The good news here is that while there are predictions for rain and thunderstorms in Mumbai on Wednesday, the forecast for the evening is much better , with most of the rain expected to take place in late morning and afternoon. Please use Chrome browser for a more accessible video player Harry Brook took an amazing one-handed catch at slip, leaving Ben Stokes dumfounded, as England beat Zimbabwe at Trent Bridge Stokes' face was reminiscent of Stuart Broad's on this very ground during the 2015 Ashes, when Stokes himself had pouched a remarkable one-handed effort in the cordon off Broad while the now Sky Sports pundit was razing Australia for 60 with 8-15.Off-spinner Bashir was England's most prolific bowler in this innings, finishing with figures of 6-81 and nine wickets in the match, as the hosts bowled Zimbabwe out for 255 in their second dig - Bashir ending Raza's hopes of a first Test ton in eight years when Brook took a regulation catch at slip, 45 minutes after his spectacular one. Please use Chrome browser for a more accessible video player Watch how England spinner Shaoh Bashir pinned Sean Williams lbw for 88 during his six-wicket haul Williams, who smoked a 42-ball half-century as he feasted on the width he was offered by the England quicks, was lbw to Bashir, two overs after the same bowler had seen Curran overturn an lbw dismissal on 30 with the ball set to shoot over the stumps. Stokes then caught Curran at the third time of asking after shelling him off his own bowling on 10 before being unable to complete a leaping one-handed take at midwicket when the left-hander, on 29 at the time, went after a Josh Tongue short ball. Once Brook's catch for the ages then snapped a 65-run fifth-wicket stand between Madhevere and Raza, Bashir dismissed the latter, the lower order and the tail, finally pinning Tanaka Chivanga (10) leg before, as England earned themselves a day off on Sunday - one they can use watching Brook's magic moment on a loop.Decisions to make for England ahead of India Test series:White-bell cricket will now take centre stage for a few weeks as England face West Indies in three one-day internationals - starting at Headingley on Thursday, live on Sky Sports Cricket (1pm first ball) - and as many T20 internationals. Stokes had appeared to indicate Bethell would slot back into the XI while on media duties ahead of the Zimbabwe Test, leading to speculation that Zak Crawley or Ollie Pope would be jettisoned, although England confirmed a day later he meant the 21-year-old left-hander would be put back in the squad, not necessarily the side.If England were minded to restore Bethell, then Crawley and Pope would need the waters at Trent Bridge, albeit against an opposition that was not top quality.Crawley scored 124 - his first Test ton since the 2023 Ashes - as he rebounded from averaging a paltry 8.66 in New Zealand, while Pope top-scored with 171 in England's 565-5 declared. That means vice-captain Pope may be the most vulnerable, although he was highly commended by Stokes while the captain spoke to reporters on Saturday eveningZimbabwe show sign as England prepare for India seriesZimbabwe were beaten well inside the distance, and their chastening opening day - when their wayward bowling allowed England to pile on 498-3 in 88 overs without really breaking sweat - will be something they rue.That display reignited the debate over whether there should be two-division Test cricket but Zimbabwe bounced back admirably over the rest of the game, despite the match ultimately ending in a hurry on Saturday afternoon. England defeated India by 7 wickets in the Birmingham test to level the series 2-2. The GT vs DC match, it was looking like India will win the match easily, but the tide turned in the last two days of the match. Chasing the record target of 378 runs, both English openers stitched a partnership of 107 runs in just 21.4. The English team suffered a mini-collapse, and they were 109-3 at one stage, but then came the record partnership of Joe Root and Jonny Bairstow. Both Root and Bairstow stitched an unbeaten partnership of 269 runs to register an easy win for the hosts, securing their individual hundreds in the process. This is the highest ever total that has been chased by the English team in their history. Man of the Match today match Jonny Bairstow won the Man of the Award for his brilliant double hundreds in the Edgbaston Test. Bairstow's knock played a big part in stabilizing England's 1st innings as the rest of the batters failed miserably in that innings. At the presentation ceremony, Bairstow said that the last month has been fantastic for him, and he loves putting the pressure back on the opposition. He also expressed the delight of having a full crowd on the final day of the test match. "It's great fun at the moment, this last month has been fantastic, we can see the smile on the boys' faces. I've stripped it all back to the basics, I'm not a big fan of bubbles and sitting in rooms playing computer games, but it's great to be back, day five sold out in 90 minutes," Jonny Bairstow said. "It's about having the enjoyment factor, not afraid of failing, putting the pressure back on the opposition, we're going to lose games along the way, but the positive brand is fun to play." Jonny Bairstow has been terrific in 2022 so far. He has played eight matches this year, where he has scored 1066 runs at an average of 82.00, courtesy of six centuries and a solitary half-century. Man of the Match Award Winners in IPL 2025 - All Matches Man of the Match winners in IPL 2025: Here we will update the Man of the Match winners in IPL 2025 for all matches played. Will update soon!!! IPL 2025 Format The format of the IPL 2025 edition will be the same as the previous year. Following are the details of the IPL 2025 Format: The ten teams are divided into two groups of five. A random draw was used to determine the groups and who plays whom across the groups once and twice. In the group stage, each team plays 14 games facing the other four teams in their group two times each (one home and one away game), four teams in the other group once, and the remaining team two times. IPL Points Table system: The team winning a match will be awarded 2 points. The losing team will not receive any points. In case of a draw or no result, both teams will be awarded 1 point. A four-game playoff stage following the Page playoff system is held after the group stage. Four games will be played in the playoffs: Qualifier 1: between the teams ranked first and second in the group stage. Eliminator: between the teams ranked third and fourth in the group stage. Qualifier 2: between the loser of Qualifier 1 and the winner of the Eliminator. Final: between the winners of Qualifiers 1 and 2. IPL 2025 Rules IPL 2025 Rules: Ahead of the IPL 2025 season, BCCI has made noticeable changes in their rule book including a change in the salary cap of the uncapped players. Each team can retain six players from their existing squad, either via retention or by using the Right to Match (RTM) option. The franchise can decide their combination for Retentions and RTMs. A team can retain a maximum of five capped players whether Indian or Overseas and a maximum of 2 uncapped players. The auction purse value of each team has been set at INR 120 crores while it was INR 100 crores for the last auction. The total salary cap will now consist of auction purse, incremental performance pay and match fees. Previously in 2024, the total salary cap (auction purse + incremental performance pay) was INR 110 Crs which will now be INR 146 Crs (2025), INR 151 Crs (2026) and INR 157 Crs (2027). As an overseas player, he has to register for the Mega Auction. In case if he fails to do so, then he will be ineligible to register in the following year's player auction. As per the new rule, an overseas player will have to mandatorily register for the mega auction (2025) if he fails to do so he will miss the subsequent small auction too. If any player registers in the player auction and after getting picked by a team and later makes himself unavailable before the start of the season, he will get banned from participating in the tournament and player auction for two seasons. A capped player will be considered an uncapped player if the player has not featured in the starting XI in any international games(Test, T20I, ODI) in the last five calendar years or does not have a Central Contract with BCCI. This will only be applicable to the Indian players. In IPL 2025, bowlers can bowl two bounces in an over. The IPL 2025 season will also retain the Impact Player Rule which was introduced in IPL 2023. Team captains can walk in with 2 different team sheets before handling their final playing 11 after the toss. Depending on the toss result, the teams can pick their best 11 after the toss. But till last season, the captains had to exchange the teams before the toss. For Example: If team A wants to bat first and then defend a total on a slow track in turning conditions and is forced to bow first they can pick the playing 11 with an extra spinner in the starting 11 and then they can replace a specialist bowler with a batter in the second innings to help with the run-chase. BCCI introduced this rule in the 2023 edition to bring forward the motto of "win toss, win match" in certain conditions. IPL 2025 will have two DRS for each inning. Players can take reviews for wides and no-balls in IPL Upon a catch dismissal, irrespective of whether the batsmen have crossed or not the incoming batsman will take the strike, except if it's the last ball of the over If rescheduling won't be possible then IPL Technical Team will see the matter. In Playoffs/Final: If Super Over or subsequent Super Overs can't be completed due to some reason then the team that has finished higher in the league will be declared as the winner. Over-rate penalty of only four fielders outside the 30-yard circle for every over not completed in the allocated time. Unfair movement of the wicketkeeper will result in a dead ball and 5 penalty runs. During the first ODI of Australia's tour of India 2023 at the Wankhede Stadium, India beat Australia by 5 wickets to attain a 1-0 lead in a three-match series. The development has resulted in India winning their first ODI at this venue since 2011. Ideally, India would've thought of dominating a 190-run chase but it wasn't to be as Australian pacers reduced them to 16/3 in the first five overs. With the ball seeming around, the likes of Ishan Kishan (3), Virat Kohli (4) and Suryakumar Yadav (0) were all caught off guard against a moving new ball. It was a match-winning 108-run partnership for the sixth wicket between India wicket-keeper batter KL Rahul (75*) and all-rounder Ravindra Jadeja (45*) which powered the home team to a comfortable victory in the 40th over. Left out of the Playing XI during the last two Border-Gavaskar Trophy 2023 Test matches, Rahul's 13th ODI half-century has further elongated his purple patch as a middle-order wicket-keeper batter (719 runs across 15 innings at an average and strike rate of 65.36 and 101.41 respectively including a century and seven half-centuries). IND vs AUS Man of the Match today 1st ODI An innings total in excess of 300 runs was being talked about when Australia all-rounder Mitchell Marsh (81) hit 10 fours and five sixes at a strike rate of 124.61 earlier in the day but it wasn't to be as the visitors lost eight wickets for 59 runs in the middle overs. Having won the toss and opted to bowl first, India stand-in captain Hardik Pandya (1/29 & 25) would've been delighted with his decision after his bowlers bundled out Australia for 189 in 35.4 overs. Pacer Mohammed Shami was the pick of the bowlers across both the teams with figures of 6-2-17-3 dismissing the likes of Josh Inglis (26), Cameron Green (12) and Marcus Stoinis (5) in successive overs. While Shami's new-ball partner Mohammed Siraj also picked three wickets, Jadeja and spinner Kuldeep Yadav dismissed two and one batter respectively. Playing an ODI after exactly eight months, Jadeja was adjudged the Player of the Match in this format after as many as 52 months. In addition to sending Marsh and Australia all-rounder Glenn Maxwell (8) back to the pavilion, Jadeja was also seen grabbing a fantastic catch at backward point off Kuldeep Yadav's bowling to dismiss Marnus Labuschagne (15) in the 23rd over. "I'm playing [an] ODI after eight months. So, was just looking to adjust as soon as possible. Luckily, [I] did well with the ball, got three [two] wickets. I was looking to build a partnership today of about 70-80 runs, and that happened," Jadeja told host broadcaster Star Sports Network during the post-match presentation ceremony. Yashasvi Jaiswal had an ordinary record in SENA countries prior to this match. But now, he has put his critics to the bed. Jasprit Bumrah-led India has scripted history. In the absence of incumbent skipper Rohit Sharma, Bumrah led the pack superbly, taking the side to an unprecedented win in the first Border-Gavaskar Trophy (BGT) Test at the Optus Stadium. Following the match, it was Bumrah who won the Player of the Match, as he took a brilliant fiver in the first innings. His spell was special as it laid a platform for India to go on top within Day 1. During the post-match presentation, Bumrah was asked who would be his player of the match if he got to choose. Bumrah replied in a very sensible manner, as he claimed that personal accolades don't make him feel overawed. At the same time, Bumrah didn't fail to mention one name who played his best Test knock ever. It was none other than Yashasvi Jaiswal, who mustered a historic 161 off 297 balls. "If I had to give man of the match award I would give it to Yashasvi Jaiswal. I think this was Yashasvi's Best Test innings," claimed Bumrah while addressing the media post the Perth Test match. Even during the chat with Adam Gilchrist, Bumrah lauded the way Jaiswal batted. "Very happy. We were put under pressure in the first innings, but the way we responded was great. I played here in 2018 - I remember the wicket started soft. This one was less spicy, we were really well prepared. I told everyone to keep faith in your ability, Jaiswal's best Test innings so far, he left the ball well."
